The Lotus Pendant light is made from six pack beer rings and a soft drink can. For more information visit Releve Design

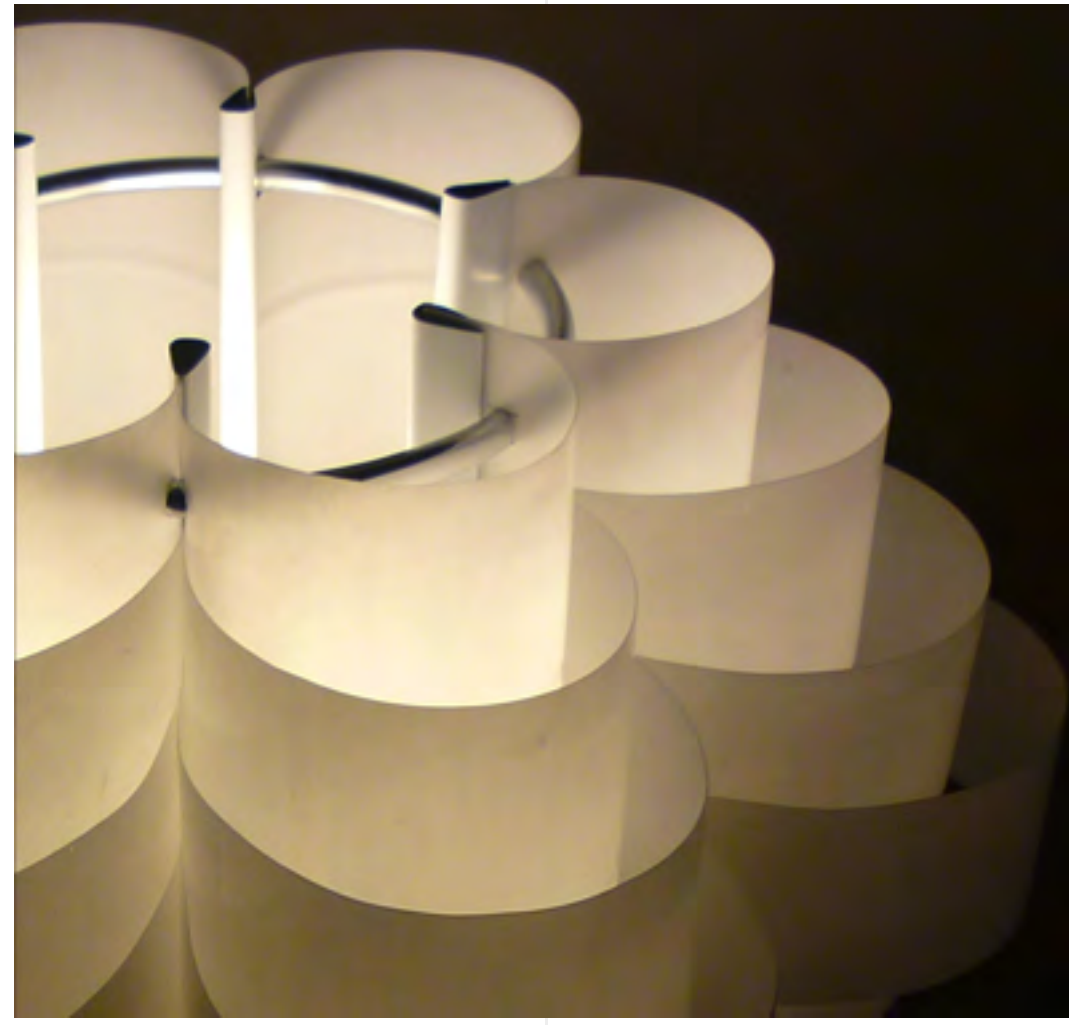


Sarah Turner specialises in making decorative lighting from waste plastic drinks bottles. The bottles are collected from local cafes and households.
